

# ITSY BITSY MINIATURE ACRYLIC PAINTING SUPPLY LIST

## **Come have fun and learn something new**

Bring any and all acrylic supplies that you may have. If you don't have anything then check out my supplies list

1. We will be using 8" x10", 6" x6", 5"x 7", 4"x 6", 4"x 4" Canvas Board (Do not buy canvas from Wal-Mart. But go to Hobby Lobby, Michaels or Amazon)



2. If you don't have any acrylic paint than I suggest you buy a small starter kit. Similar items available at Hobby Lobby, Michaels or Amazon (No folk art or ceramic bottle paint please)
3. A portable easel
4. Paper Towels
5. Small travel size Baby wipes
6. Water bucket (You can use one that oil artist use to wash out your paint brushes or get a jar that has a tight lid and place some glass rocks and place at the bottom of your jar. This will clean your brushes just fine)



7. A wet palette container or go to the Dollar Tree store and buy a plastic container 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 16" x 12" or close to it.



8. Pallet knives set. To start off you can use plastic one. Similar items available at Hobby Lobby, Michaels or Amazon
9. Spray bottle (Small)



10. A small bottle of Clear Gesso (we will use this as a medium. You can find this at Hobby Lobby, Michaels or Amazon)



- 11. Cheap paint brushes from Wal-Mart
- 12. Pencil HB
- 13. Rectangular Eraser (White)
- 14. Small trash bags

15. Travel Tote you carry or crate with wheels

### **Extras items you might need**

- A) Graphite paper, available at Hobby Lobby, Michaels or Amazon, less expensive than Amazon
- B) Pliers
- C) Small pad of paper to take notes
- D) Masking tape
- E) Ruler
- F) Small Rectangular or square hand held Mirror. Not round
- G) Small pencil sharpener
- H) Powder-Free Exam Disposable gloves
